Partial Closure of Perryfields High School

During this period of national concern about the Covid-19 virus, the school has been following all advice issued by the Department of Education and Public Health England to fully support efforts to contain, delay and mitigate the impact of the virus within the school and the wider community.

We are determined to do all that we can to maintain the fullest possible educational provision for our students at all times. We are closely monitoring the absence of students and staff who need to self-isolate and have therefore decided that the school will be partially closed to Years 8, 9 and 11 on Friday 20th March. For the time being, Years 7 and 10 need to be in school as normal.
