Dear Parent/Carer,

As the end of the summer holidays approach, I wanted to let you know how much we are looking forward to welcoming your child back to school for the new term. With the exception of when we were able to have our Year 10s return in June, the summer term was disappointing so it will be a pleasure to welcome all of our students back in September.

As you are aware following my letter in July, the Jubilee Block has reopened. Following all the necessary repairs and a deep clean, the building is now fully functional. I would like to thank you again for your patience and understanding whilst we had to operate within temporary mobile classrooms and lose so many facilities - we have our basketball and tennis courts back!

A reminder that due to the health and safety requirements around Covid-19, that the start of term is going to be staggered across year groups, to help to ensure that a level of distance can be maintained. On Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September, the school will be open for our Year 7 cohort only. They are to arrive in school by 8.30am.

Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September is the start of term for all remaining year groups. A reminder of the arrival and departure times and locations are below:

When your child does return to school, they are to do so in full school uniform. If you have experienced any difficulties with regards to acquiring new uniform for your child, please send them into school with a note and we will do what we can to support them. Your child will be told by the PE department in their first PE lesson when they will need their PE kit. On PE days, your child is to attend school in their kit.

We appreciate your support and understanding as we continue to navigate through these unusual circumstances. We are hopeful that at some point this term, the school will be given the go ahead to resume regular times of the day. As soon as the government makes any significant changes, I will write to you again.

We would like to wish you well for the remainder of the holiday and look forward to working with you in the academic year ahead.
